#### **Wood Products**

1 Plywood, 3/4" Thick, Full Sheet


#### Hardware & Supplies

- 4 Full Overlay Door Hinges
- 25 11/4" Pocket Hole Screws
- 4 Tapered Legs & Hardware



# Cut List & Parts

- Top, 15 X 34"
- 1 Bottom, 15 X 34"
- Sides , 15 X 21"
- Shelf, 14 1/2 X 32 1/2"
- Back Panel , 21 X 32 1/2"
- Doors , 17 X 22 1/2"

#### **Check Dimensions**

Check the dimensions of the project to make sure it fits your space.



### **Make Cuts**

Use the cut list to make your cuts.








#### **Create Frame**

Create your frame by attaching top, bottom, and side pieces with 11/4" pocket hole screws and glue.








### **Add Back Panel**

Add back panel with 1 1/4" pocket hole screws and wood glue.








## Add Shelf (Optional)

Add a shelf to your build with 1 1/4" pocket hole screws & wood glue, if needed. I used mine for a 3D printer, so no shelving was added!








### **Create Handle Cut Outs**

Use a jig saw to create cut outs for the door handles. The ones on this particular cabinet are 1/2" wide and 3" tall on each door.








#### **Attach Doors**

Use the Kreg cabinet hardware jig to add your full overlay concealed hinges.








## **Add Legs**
