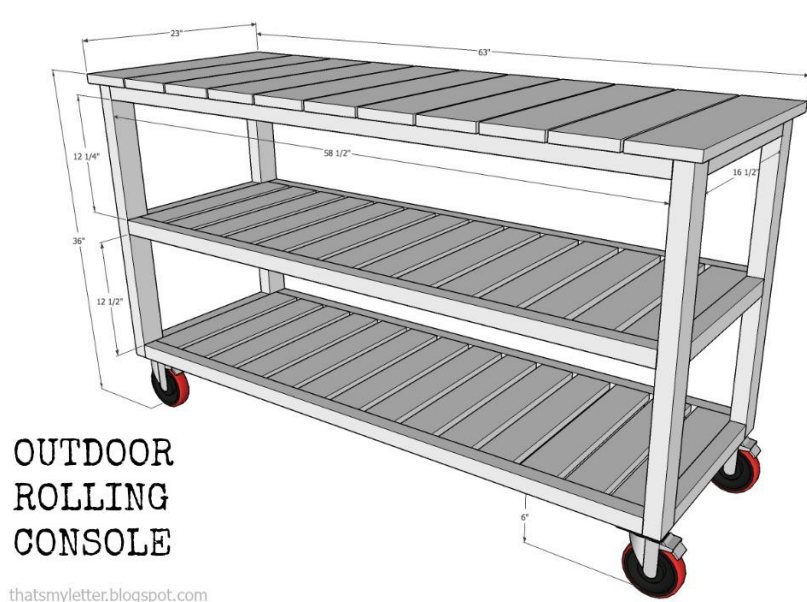


# outdoor rolling console

- 2** Board , 1x6 , 96"
- 6** Board , 1x4 , 96"
- 2** Board , 2x3 , 96"
- 3** Board , 2x2 , 96"
- 3** Board , 2x2 , 72"

## Hardware & Supplies

- 4** 5" Casters (2 With Brakes)
- 50** 1 1/4" Pocket Hole Screws
- 25** 2 1/2" Pocket Hole Screws
- 50** 2" Finish Nails

# Cut List & Parts

- 11** Top Slats , 1x6 @ 23"
- 28** Shelf Slats , 1x4 @ 28"
- 4** Legs , 2x3 @ 29 1/4"
- 6** Frame Front & Back , 2x2 @ 58 1/2"
- 6** Frame Sides , 2x2 @ 16 1/2"
