
A simple frame for any size mirror that creates depth and hides hardware on the backside. A great solution to finish off an unframed mirror.

Hardware & Supplies

- 4 11/4" Pocket Hole Screws
- 8 11/4" Finish Nails
- **6** Mirror Clips
- **1** Mirror



Cut List & Parts

- 2 Long Side Interior , 1x2 @ 18 1/2", Both Ends 45 Degree Miter
- 2 Short Side Interior, 1x2 @ 16 1/2", Both Ends 45 Degree Miter
- **2** Long Side Exterior , 1x2 @ 20", Both Ends 45 Degree Bevel
- 2 Short Side Exterior , 1x2 @ 18", Both Ends 45 Degree Bevel
