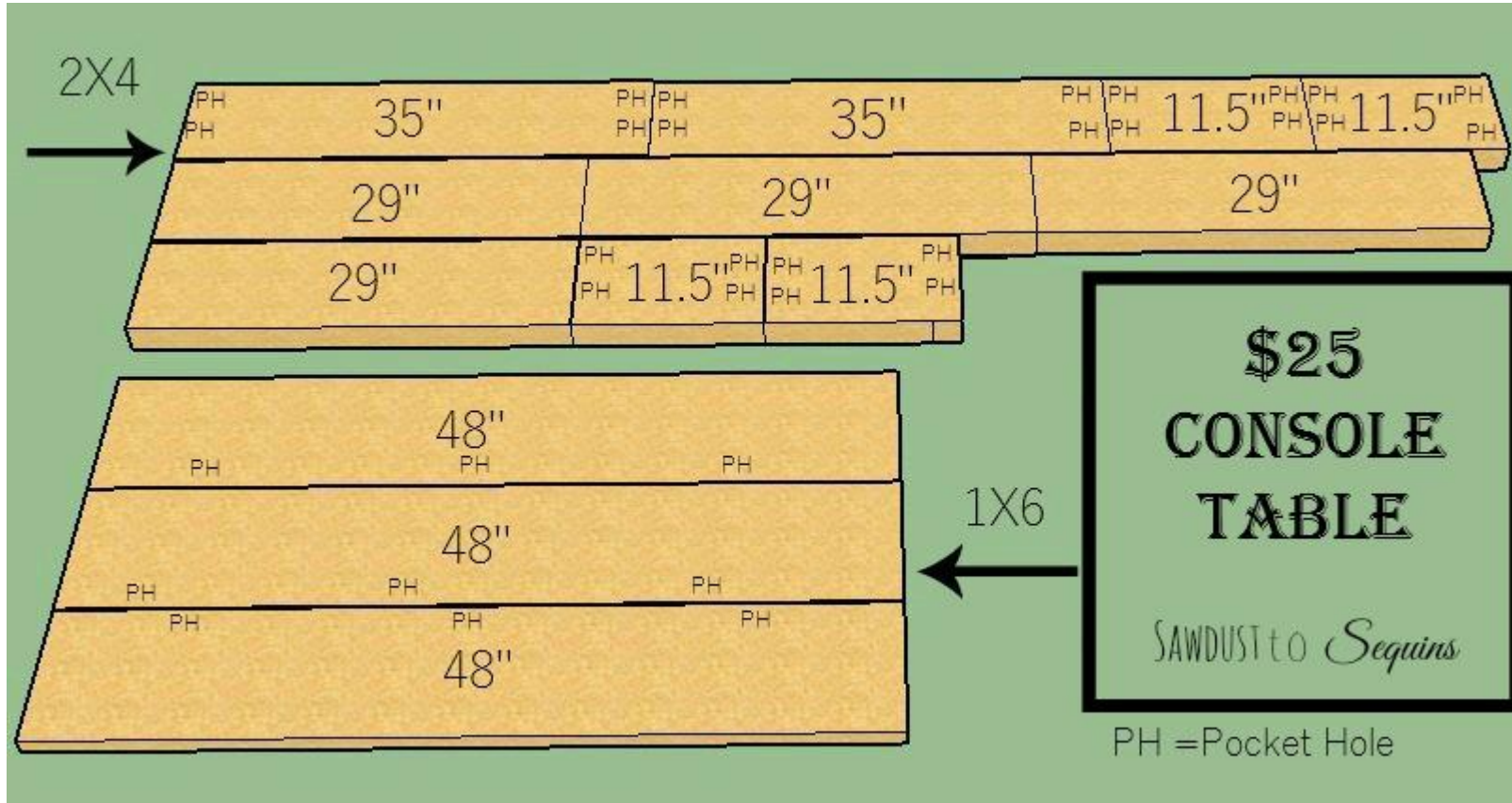
24 2 1/2" Pocket Hole Screws

9 1 1/4" Pocket Hole Screws

4 2" Wood Screws

Cut List & Parts

- 2 Middle Table Top Braces , 2x4x35
- 4 Side Table Top Pieces , 2x4x11.5
- 4 Table Leg Side Pieces , 2x4x29
- 3 Table Top Boards , 1x6x48

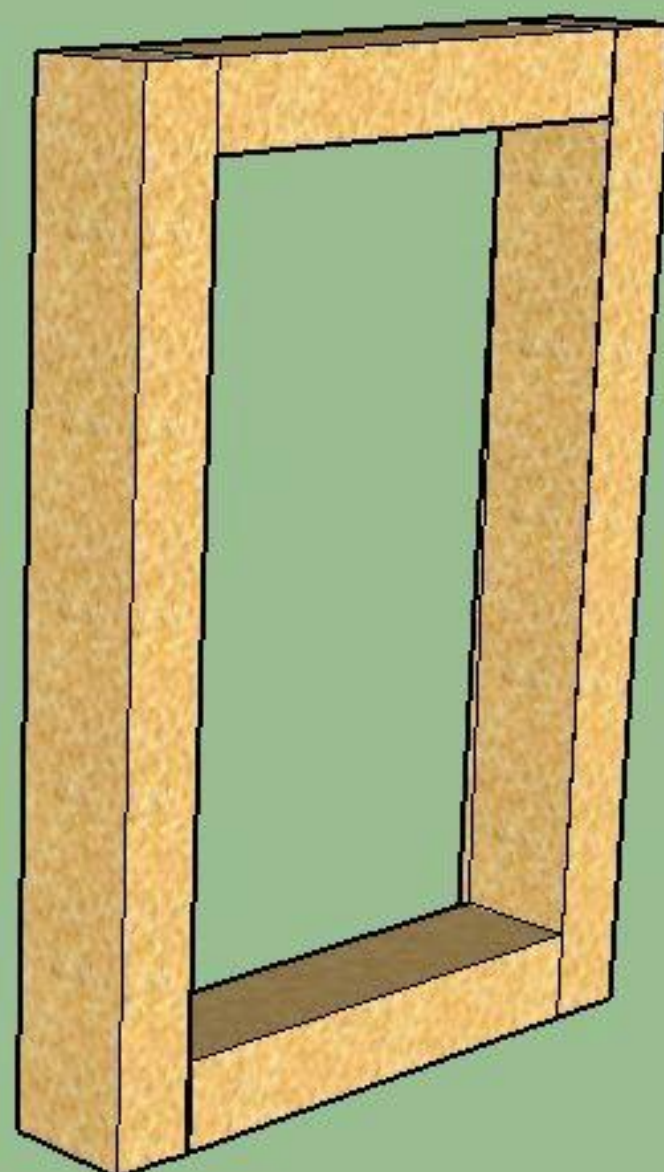
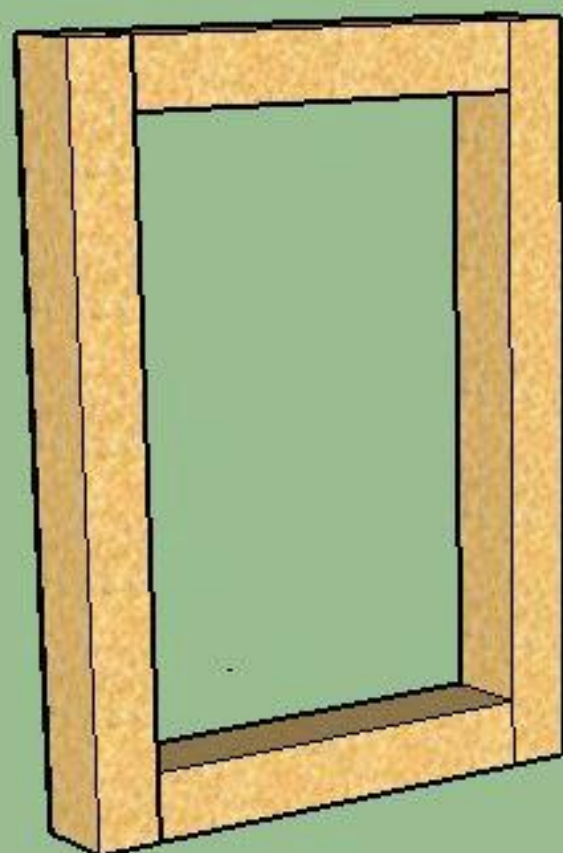


Directions

1

Build Leg Supports

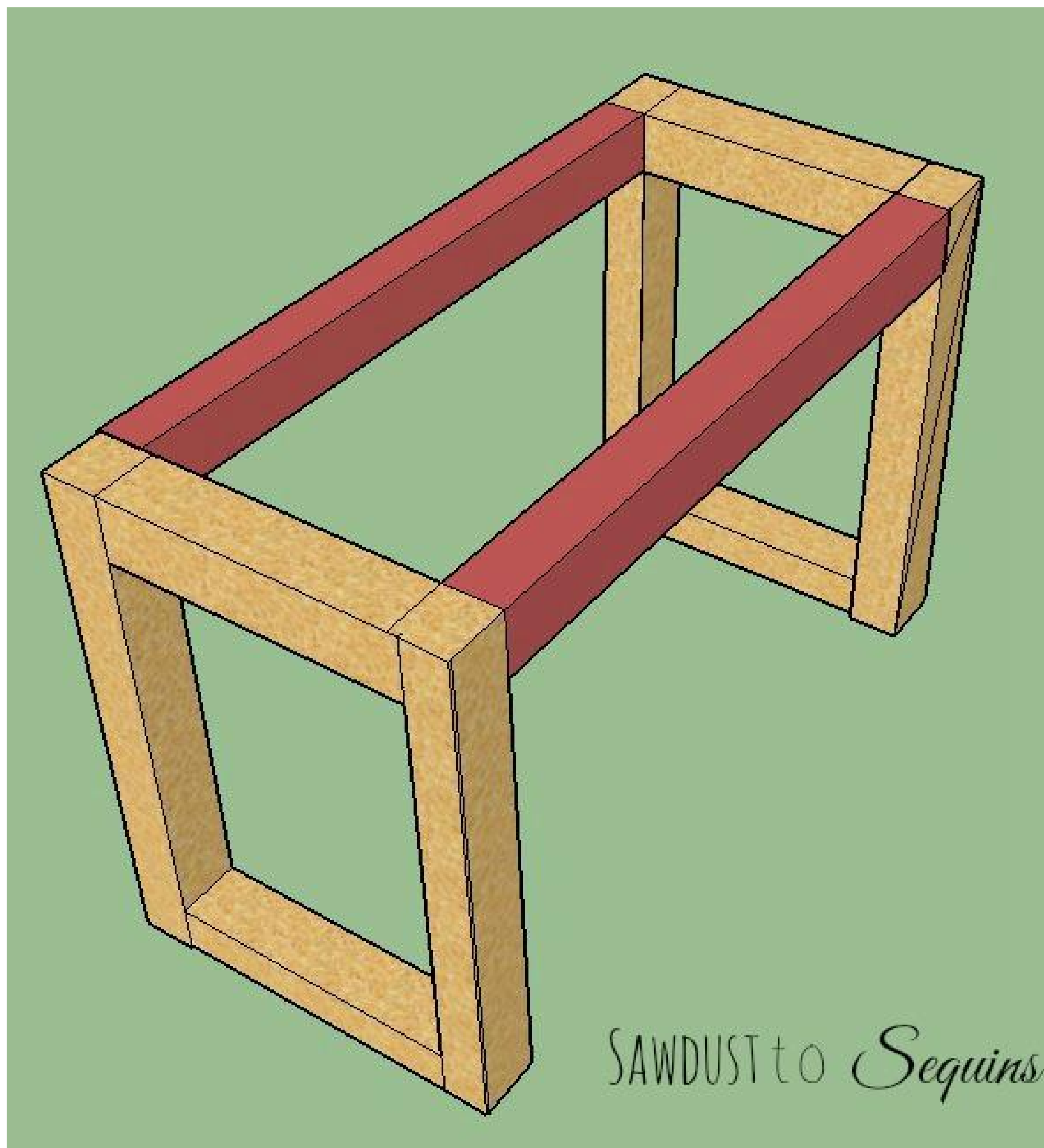
Attach the 11.5" pieces to the 29" pieces to form a box. (11.5" pieces go inside of 29" pieces. Repeat for both legs of the table.



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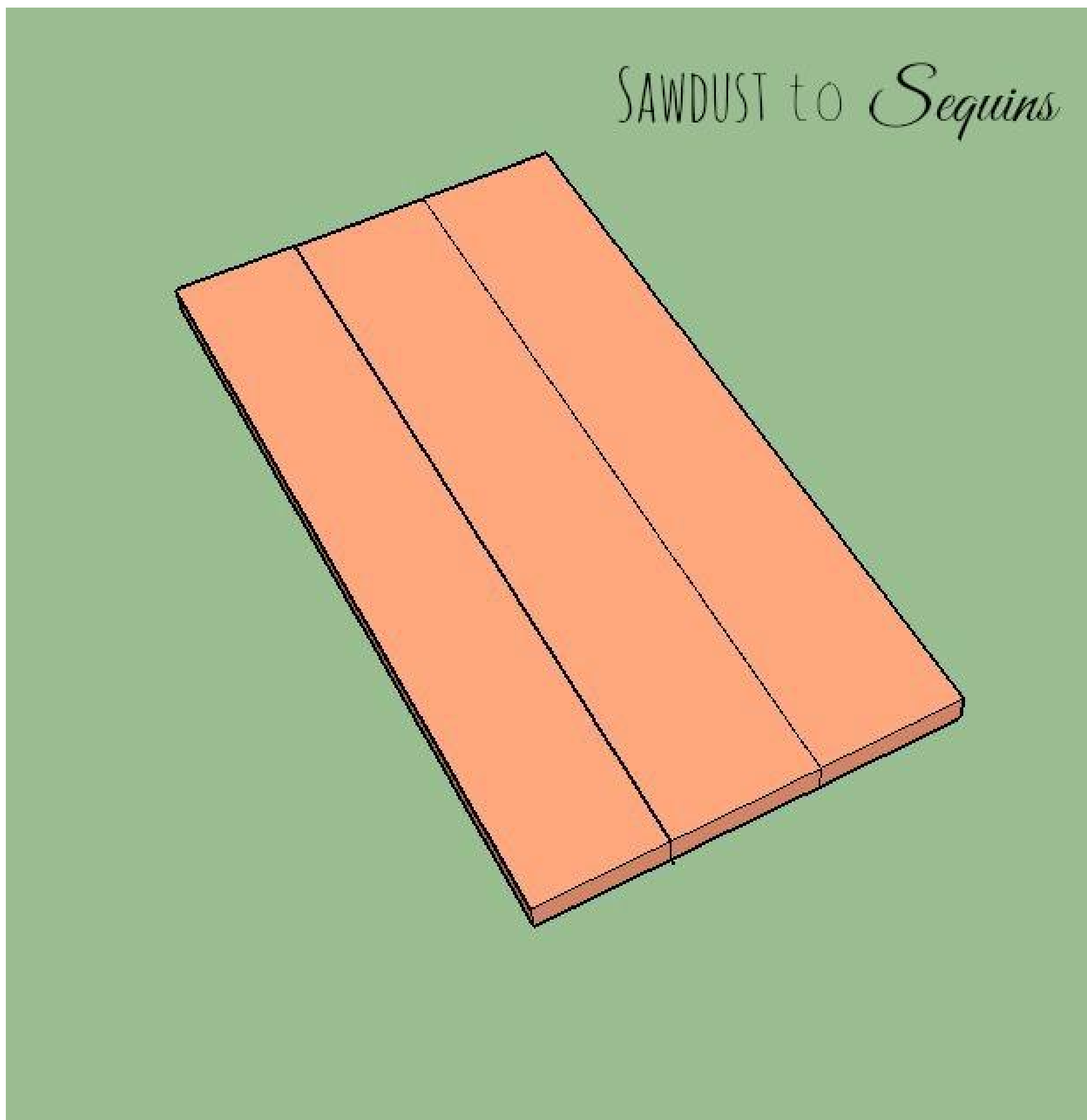
2**Attach Table Top Supports**

With legs facing each other, attach middle 35" braces to the tops of the front and back (braces are placed inside of table legs components).



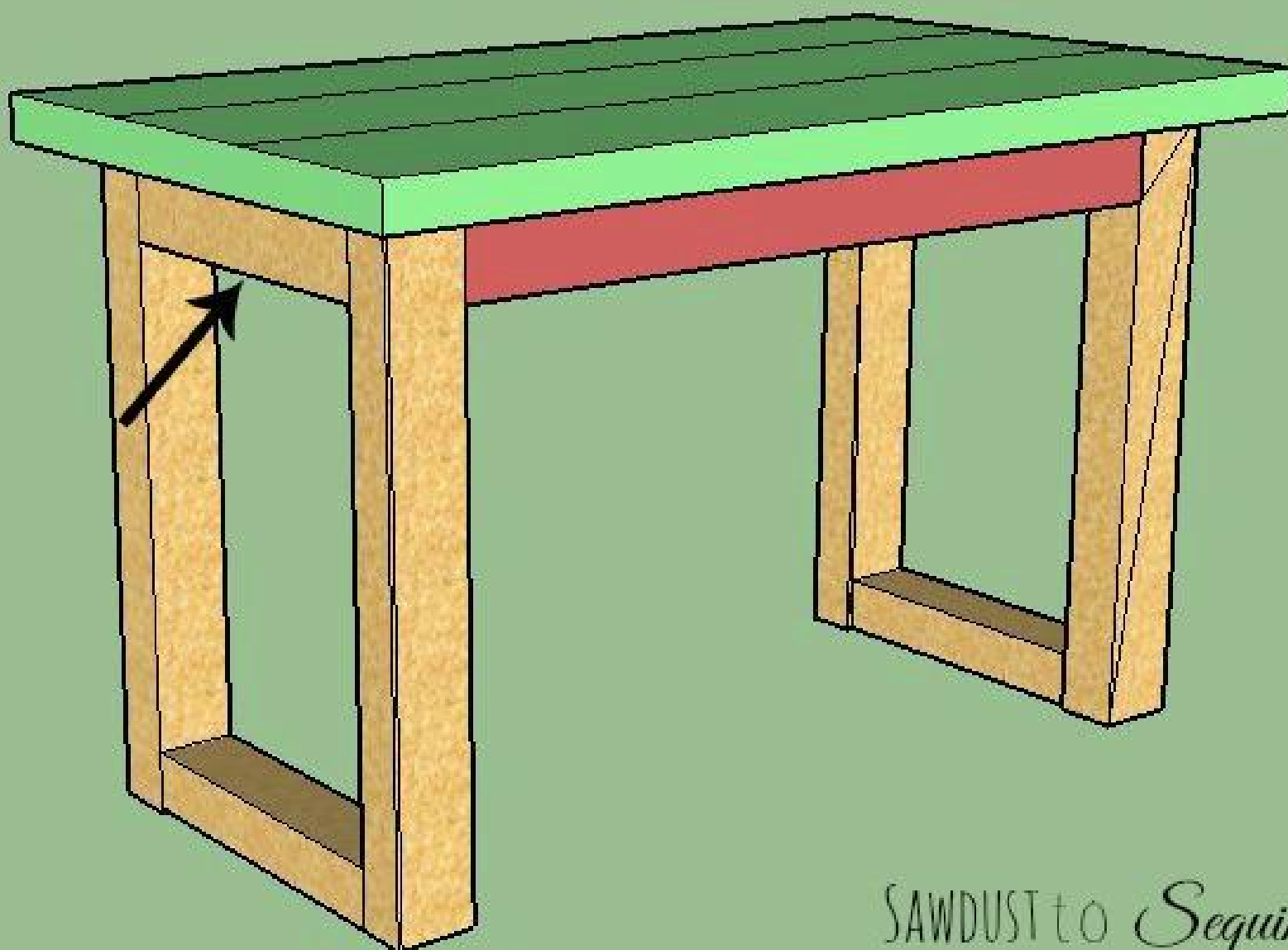
3**Assemble Table Top**

With pocket hole screws, screw the 3 1x6x4 boards together to form the top of the table.



4**Attach Table Top**

Attach the top to the table legs with 2" wood screws through the bottom of the leg assembly.

Sand your table,
stain with color of choice, and enjoy your
