Clean up your ever growing paint collection with this vertical wall hanger. Store your paint brushes & 2 ounce, and 8 ounce paint bottles.

Kreg Tools







Other Tools

Circular saw

Miter saw

Drill

Paddle bit

Sander

Materials

Wood Products

1 Plywood, 5'x5'x1/2"

Hardware & Supplies

- 1 Box Of Kreg Pocket Hole Screws (See Tools List)
- 1 Golden Oak Stain



Cut List & Parts

- 1 Plywood , 18"X40"x1/2"
- **2** Plywood , 2"X40"x1/2"
- **13** Plywood , 17"X2"x1/2"



Directions

1

Step one

Cut your 1/2" material down to 18X40 inches.

Step two

Make horizontal lines every 3"s starting 2"s from the top until you've made 12 lines. Then make vertical intersecting lines every 2"s.








Step three

Drill 1 3/8" holes where your vertical and horizontal lines intersect.





Step four

Cutout and then pocket hole 2"X40" body pieces to the back of your storage.







Step five

Cutout and then pocket hole 2"x17" shelf pieces to the back of your storage.



Step six

Sand holes and face of storage thoroughly.







Step seven

Cutout and attach 2"X2" pieces to the face of your storage. One with an 1 1/5" hole in it.





Step eight

Cut a 2" piece of 3/4" material in half at a 45 degree angle. Mount one piece into your storage and one piece onto the wall so that they match fit each other and the one on the wall holds the storage up.








Step nine

Hang your storage on the French cleat you made.





Step ten

Fill your storage up with all of your paints and enjoy!
