- **3** Shelves , 26 1/2" X 7 1/4" X 3/4"
- 6 Trim , 26 1/2" X 1/4" X 1/4"




## Directions



### **Attach Bottom Shelf**


Drill pocket holes in the short ends of each of the shelves. Attach one shelf to the ends of the front and back flush with the bottom edge.





### **Attach Shelves**

Attach the other two shelves the same way with 11" of space in between.



### Attach Trim

Attach the trim pieces on the outside edge of the top of each shelf using wood glue and clamps.





### **Attach Casters**

Attach the casters onto the underside of the bottom shelf. We attached ours to the end.





### Attach Handle

5

Attach the handle approximately 5" down from the top of the front.
