## Assemble Leg 1

Use $11 / 2$ pocket holes underneath $2 \times 4(123 / 8)$ to join together $2 \times 4$ legs.

Use $21 / 2$ pocket screws.

## Assemble Leg 2

Repeat step 1 to make the second leg


## Add Bottom Braces

Add bottom braces to legs with $11 / 2$ pocket holes under $2 \times 4$ (white) using $21 / 2$ pocket screws


## 4 <br> Add Bottom Seating

Add $1 \times 6$ to legs using 2 " screws. $1 \times 6$ should hang off the edge of the legs by a $1 / 2$ inch. $1 \times 6$ should be flush with back.


## Add Additional Seating

Add the additional $1 \times 6$ 's using 2 "screws and leave $1 / 8$ of space in between each piece.


## Add Back Seating

Add $7 \times 6$ 's to the back using 2"screws leaving $7 / 8$ of space in between.


## Add Side Under Seating

Add $1 \times 4$ 's on the sides of the bench with 2 " screws into the $2 \times 4$ legs.


## Add Front Under Seating

Add the front $1 \times 4$ under the seat using 2 " screws into the
$2 \times 4$ legs


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
