Materials

Wood Products

- **1** Board, 2x2, 72"
- **1** Board , 1x5 , 4 1/2" Scrap
- **1** Board , 2x6 , 5 1/2" Scrap
- **1** Board , 2x8 , 7 1/4" Scrap
- **1** Board , 1x8 , 6 1/4" Circle
- 1 Plywood, 1/4" Thick, 53/4" Circle
- **1** Board , 1x6 , 4" Star

Hardware & Supplies

- 6 2 1/2" Spax Wood Screws
- 4 11/4" Spax Wood Screws



Cut List & Parts

- 1 Post, 2 X 2 @ 57"
- **1** Base 3, 3/4" X 4 1/2" X 4 1/2"
- **1** Base 2 , 1 1/2" X 5 1/2" X 5 1/2"
- **1** Base 3, 1 1/2" X 7 1/4" X 7 1/4"
- 1 Small Circle Sign , 1/4" X 5 3/4" Diameter
- 1 Large Circle Sign , 3/4" X 6 1/4" Diameter
- 1 Star , 3/4" X 4" Star
- 1 Sign Dowel , 5/16" X 3"
- 1 Star Dowel , 5/16" X 4"



Overall dimensions 66 3/4h x 7 1/4" x 7 1/4"




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Starting 2" from the end attach one pocket hole jig at center using the face frame clamp and drill a pocket hole. To make the next pocket hole line up the jig using the edge of the first hole as a guide. This will ensure about 3/4" spacing between pocket holes. Repeat this process until you have 25 pocket holes.






Attach post to base 3 at center using wood glue and at least $2-2\frac{1}{2}$ " countersunk wood screws. Considering predrilling so the post doesn't split.








Prepare the remaining base 1 and base 2 pieces by attaching the smaller base 2 to the larger base 1 using wood glue and 2 ½" countersunk wood screws.








Attach the post / base 3 portion using wood glue and 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " countersunk wood screws.







To make the circular sign at top cut out the two wood circles. Paint as desired and then attach the smaller 1/4" plywood circle to the larger back circle using super glue or wood glue. Drill a 5/16" hole into the larger circle and insert the dowel using wood glue. Predrill a 5/16" hole at the top center of the post and insert the dowel with the sign.







Cut out the 4" star from $\frac{3}{4}$ " thick plywood (use pattern below). Paint as desired. Predrill a $\frac{5}{16}$ " hole at center bottom and insert the $\frac{5}{16}$ " wood dowel using wood glue.
