

Materials

Wood Products

- **1** Board , 1" X 11-1/2" , 43"
- **2** Board , 1" X 1" , 48"

Hardware & Supplies

- 1 Wood Glue
- 1 Sandpaper
- 1 Wood Stain
- Polyurethane



Cut List & Parts

- 4 Small Tier Legs Side Pieces, 1"x1"x2-1/4"
- 2 Small Tier Legs Bottom Pieces, 1"x1"x2-3/4"
- **4** Medium Tier Legs Side Pieces , 1"x1"x5"
- **4** Medium Tier Legs Top & Bottom Pieces , 1"x1"x2-3/4"
- **4** Large Tier Legs Side Pieces , 1"x1"x7"
- 4 Large Tier Legs Top & Bottom Pieces 1"x1"x , 1"x1"x4-1/4"
- **1** Small Tier Top , 1"x20"x4-3/4"
- **1** Medium Tier Top , 1"x22"x4-3/4"
- **1** Large Tier Top , 1"x27"x6-1/4"



Directions

1

Cut Lumber

Cut lumber to size, then organize into groups: small, medium, and large tiers.








Assemble Small Tier Legs

Using wood glue and clamps, assemble the legs of the small tier.








Assemble Medium Tier Legs

Using wood glue and clamps, assemble the legs of the medium tier.








Assemble Large Tier Legs

Using wood glue and clamps, assemble the legs of the large tier.








Attach Legs to Small Tier Top

Using wood glue and clamps, attach completed legs to the small tier top, 1-1/2" from the edge. Use a carpenter's square to ensure legs are attached at 90 degrees.








Attach Legs to Medium Tier Top

Using wood glue and clamps, attach completed legs to the medium tier top, 1-1/2" from the edge. Use a carpenter's square to ensure legs are attached at 90 degrees.








Attach Legs to Large Tier Top

Using wood glue and clamps, attach completed legs to the large tier top, 1-1/2" from the edge. Use a carpenter's square to ensure legs are attached at 90 degrees.





Sand

Sand all faces and the legs of each tier.





Stain

Stain all faces and legs of each tier. Once stain is dry, protect with several layers of polyurethane.
