


# Kitchen Step Stool

# Materials

## Wood Products

- 1 Board , 1x8 , 96"
- 1 Board , 1x2 , 36"

## Hardware & Supplies

- 8 1-1/4" Pocket Screws
- 12 1-1/2" Brad Nails

# Cut List & Parts

- 1 Top Of Stool , 1 X 6 X 16
- 2 Legs , 1 X 6 X 8
- 3 Braces , Varies

## Cut Wood

Cut scrap wood for the top of the stool to desired width. I made mine 16" wide and used two pieces of leftover tongue and groove wood.

**2****Cut wood for legs**

Cut two pieces of 1" x 8" to eight inches. Bevel cut the edges to eight degrees. Drill four pocket holes into one end of each leg piece. Attach legs with pocket screws.



**3****Attach braces**

Bevel cut three of 1" x 2" to lengths necessary for braces between the legs for strength. Attach with brad nails or pocket screws.
