Wood Products

- 1 Plywood , 3/4" Thick , Full Sheet
- 1 Plywood , 1/4" Thick , Quarter Sheet
- **4** Board , 2x2 , 96"
- 1 Board , 1x2 , 96"

Hardware & Supplies

- **48** 21/2" Pocket Hole Screws
- **24** 11/4" Pocket Hole Screws
- 6 2" Wood Screws
- 4 1/2" Lath Screws
- 12 11/4" Finish Nails

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Cut List & Parts

- 6 Legs, 2 X 2 @ 29 1/4"
- 6 Side Frames Top / Bottom , 2 X 2 @ 19 3/4"
- 2 Side Panels , 3/4" X 19 3/4" X 24 5/8"
- **4** Short Cross Supports , 1 X 2 @ 11 1/8"
- 2 Back Long Cross Supports , 2 X 2 @ 26 3/8"
- 1 Front Long Cross Support , 1 X 2 @ 26 3/8"
- **1** Top , 3/4" X 24" X 44"
- 1 Shelf Ledge , 3/4" X 26 3/8" X 22 3/4"
- 1 Backing , 1/4" X 14" X 27 1/4"

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


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Step 1

Step 1: Make the side frames. Attach the horizontal piece to the legs using wood glue and 2 ½" pocket hole screws.

Make 3.




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Step 2

Step 2: Make the side panels. Attach the side panel wall to the frame using wood glue and 1 1/4" pocket hole screws.

Make 2.




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Step 3

Step 3: Attach the short cross supports to the interior side of one wall panel. I suggest placing the metal drawer unit temporarily in position to ensure proper spacing.




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Step 4: Attach the other side wall panel to the cross supports using 1 ¼" pocket hole screws.




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Step 5: Construct the desk base by attaching the long cross supports from the open frame to the side wall panel.




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Step 6: Attach the desk top the frame using countersunk screws.



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Step 7

Step 7: Insert the metal drawer unit frame and attach using $\frac{1}{2}$ " lath screws at all four corners.




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Step 8: Attach the open shelf ledge to the legs using 1 ¼" pocket hole screws.




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Step 9: Attach the backing to the frame using 1 ¼" finish nails.



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
