SUPPLY LIST

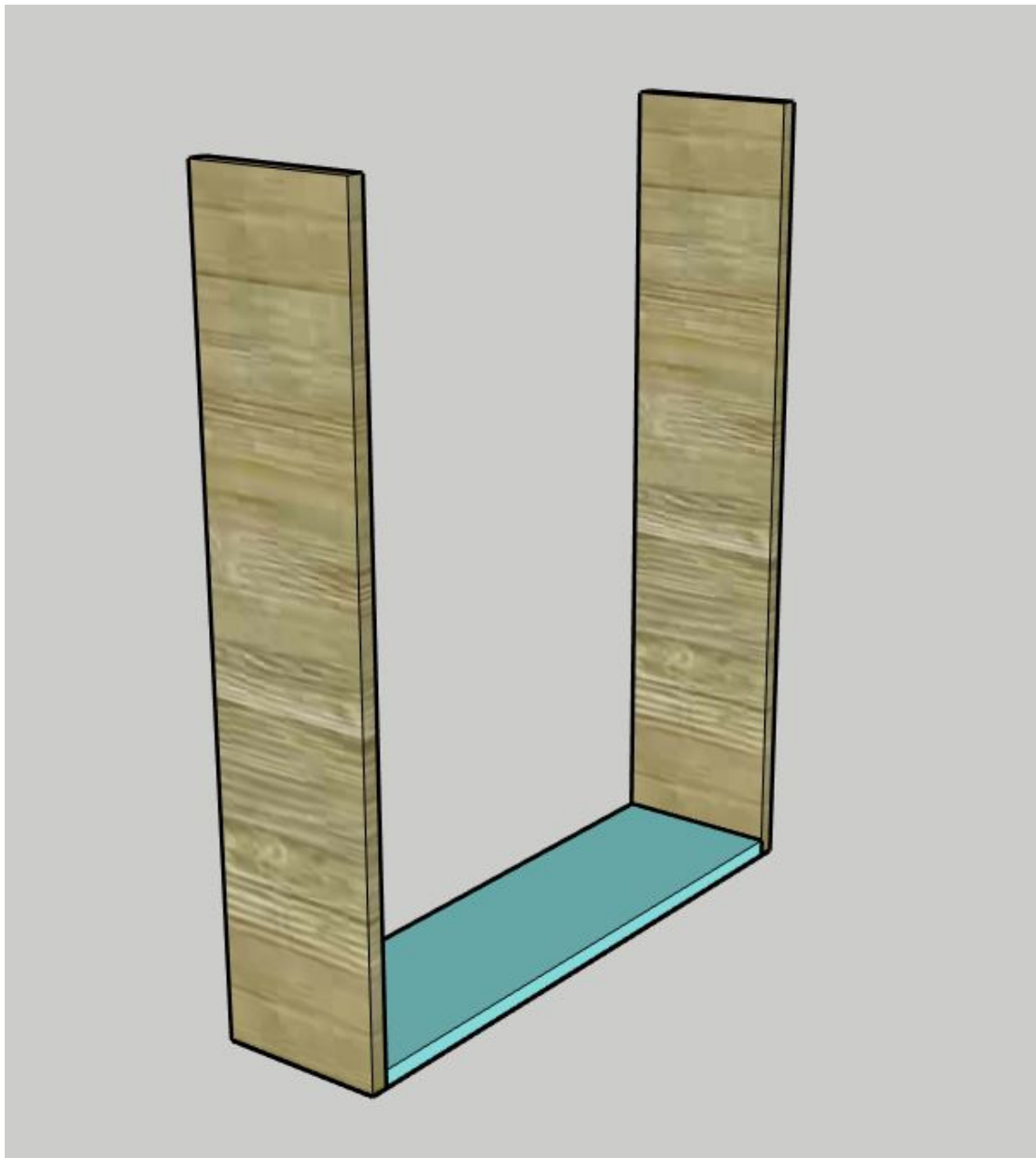
- (2) 8' 1x8 boards
- (4) 2" rubber casters
- (1) drawer pull of your choice
- Wood glue
- Stain and sealant

CUT LIST

- (2) Front and Back- 34"x7 1/4"x3/4"
- (3) Shelves- 26 1/2"x7 1/4"x3/4"
- (6) Trim- 26 1/2"x1/4"x1/4"

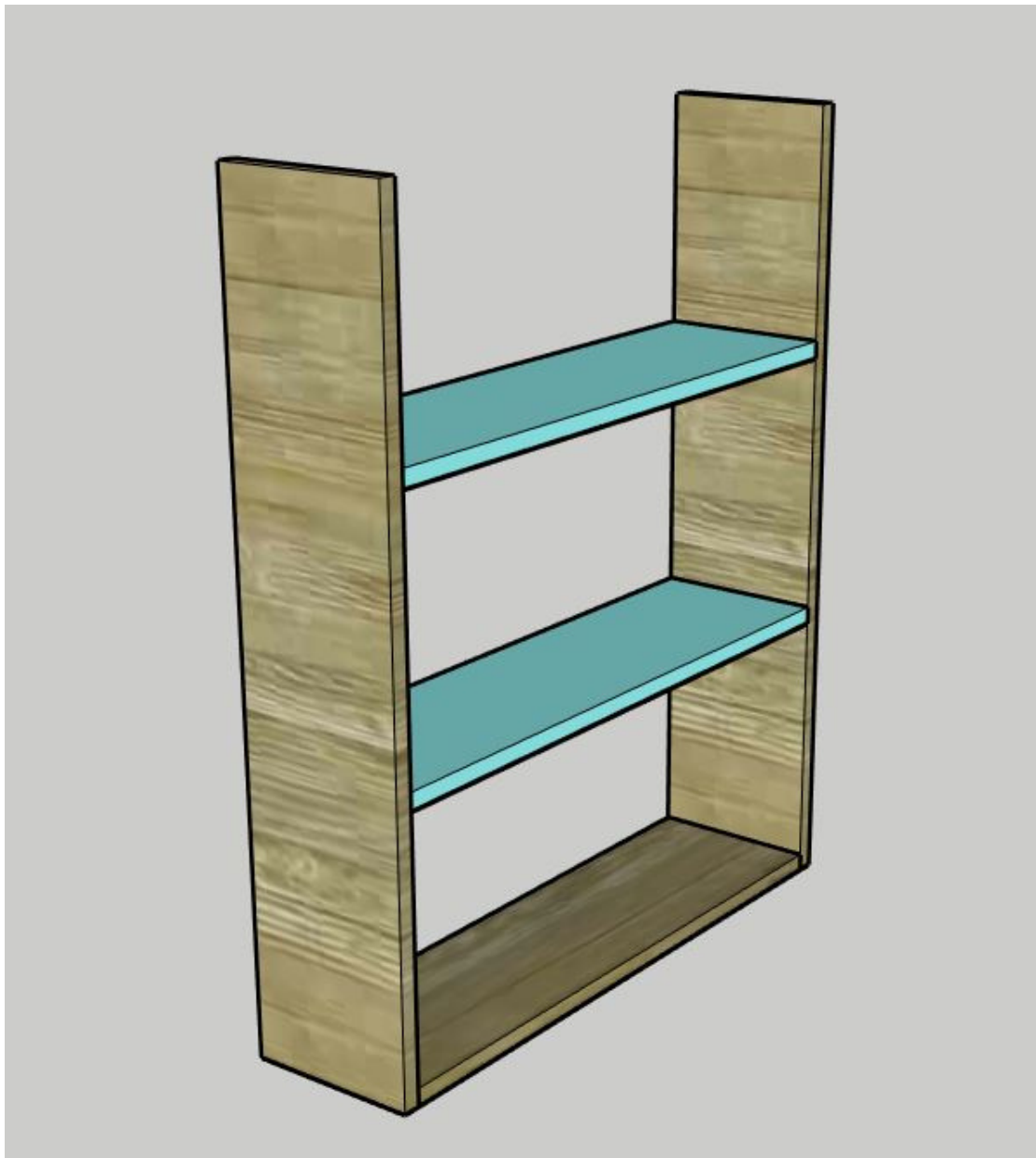
STEP ONE- ATTACH BOTTOM SHELF

- Drill pocket holes in the short ends of each of the Shelves.
- Attach one Shelf to the ends of the Front and Back flush with the bottom edge.



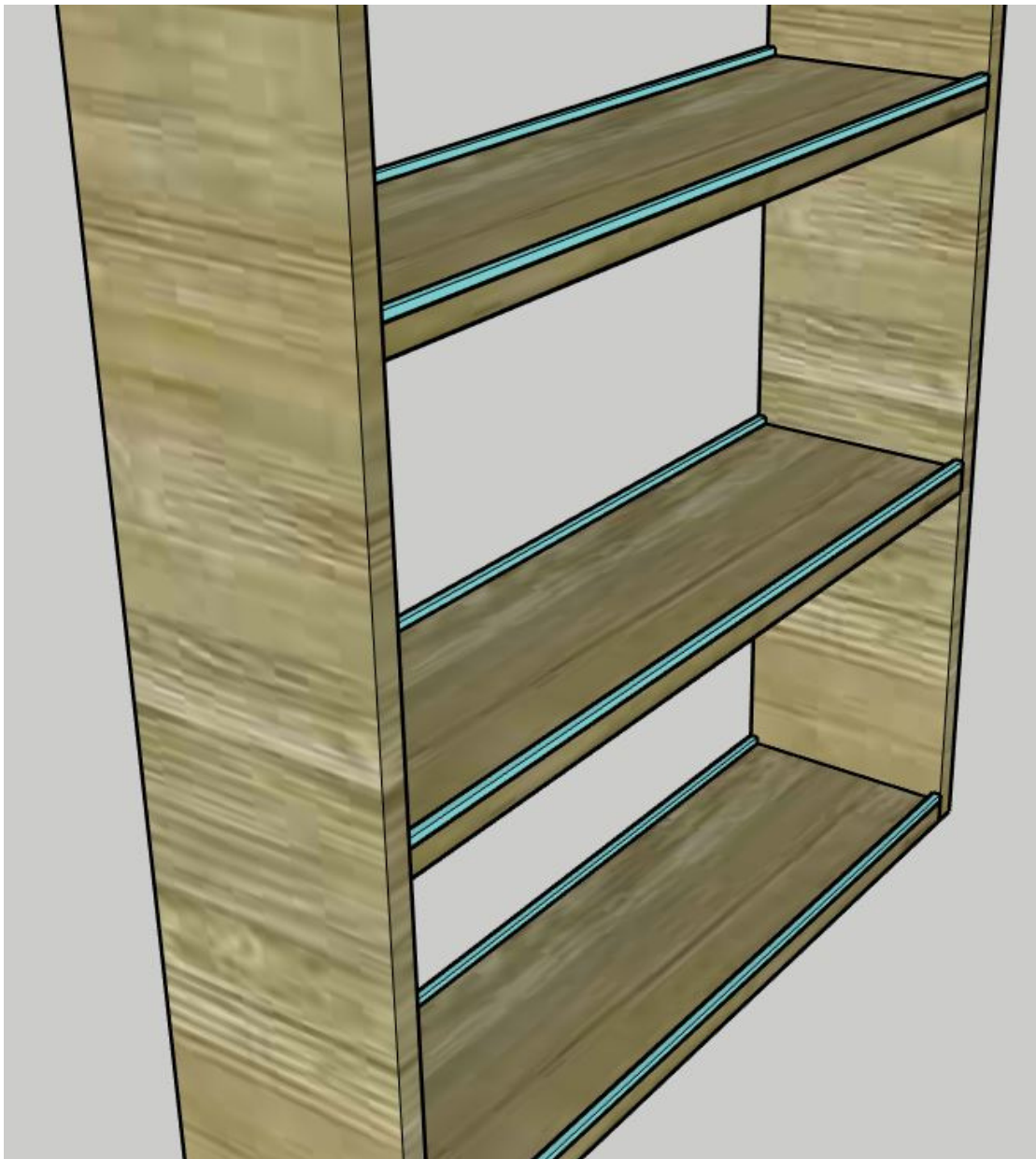
STEP TWO- ATTACH SHELVES

- Attach the other two Shelves the same way with 11" of space in between.



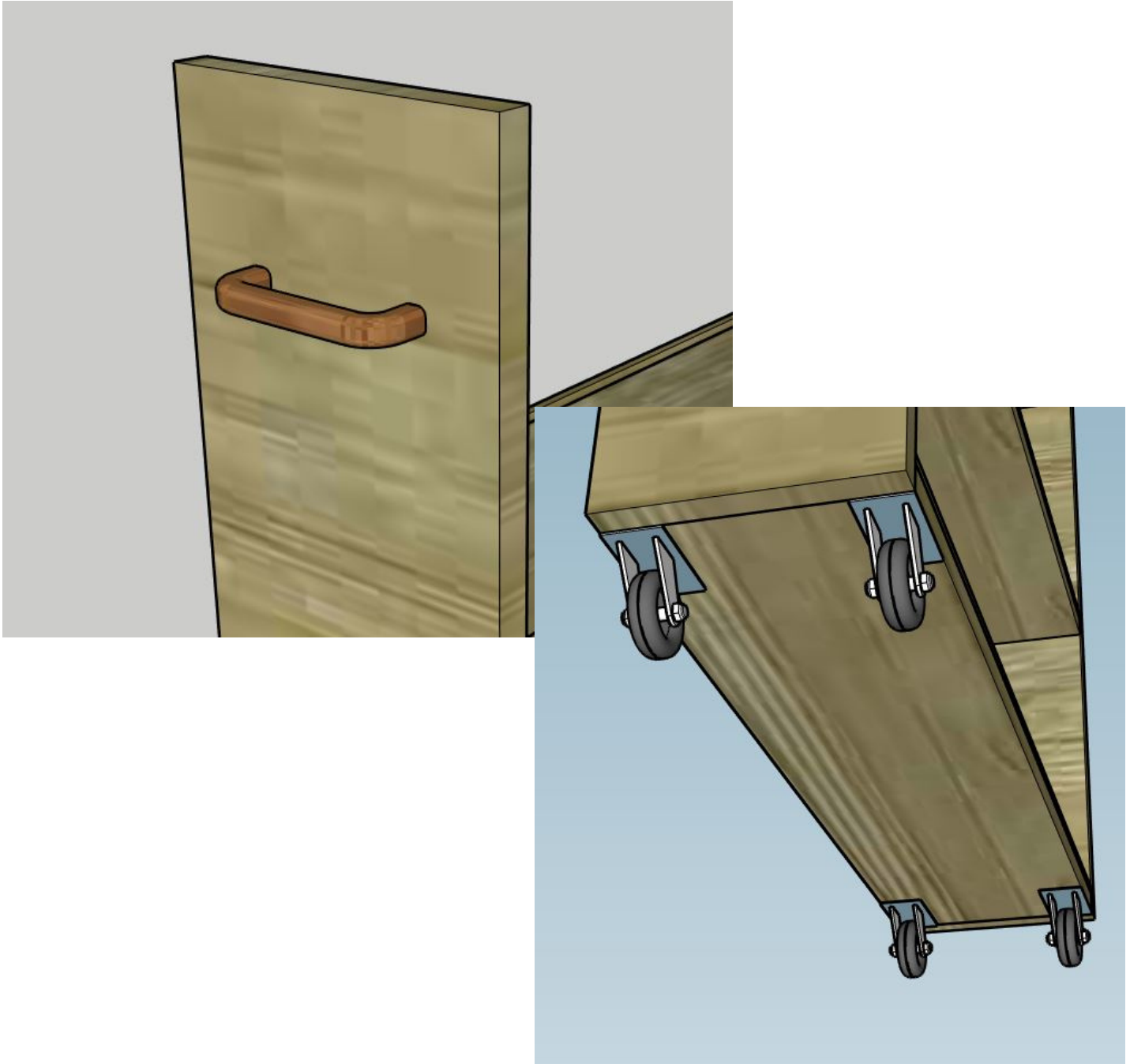
STEP THREE- ATTACH TRIM

- Attach the Trim pieces on the outside edge of the top of each Shelf using wood glue and clamps.



STEP FOUR- ATTACH HARDWARE

- Attach the casters onto the underside of the bottom Shelf. We attached ours to the end.
- Attach the handle approximately 5" down from the top of the Front.



STEP FIVE- ENJOY!
