
# OUTDOOR SOFA MADE FROM 2X6S

This DIY outdoor sofa is made out of pieces of 2x6 that are screwed together with pocket holes.



## 1. CUT THE 2X6s

**SEAT BOARDS:** 

Cut 5 pieces of 2x6 at a length of 96"

**BACK REST**:

Cut 2 pieces of 2x6 at a length of 72"

**LEGS AND ANGLE SUPPORTS:** 

Cut 6 pieces of 2x6 at a length of 28"


### 2. ASSEMBLE THE LEG PANELS

- Screw on back rest boards

Use pocket holes to connect the pieces. I placed on the holes on the inside or under side of the pieces so that they would be less visible.

## 3. ASSEMBLE THE SOFA

- Screw the leg panels to the first four seat boards leaving 1/4" gaps.
- Screw the angle supports to seat panels with pocket holes
- Cut notches in the last seat board to fit around angle supports

Screw through the angle supports and into the back rest boards

Cut notches in last board and slide around angle supports

first 4 seat boards

Use pocket holes to screw angle supports to inside of leg panels

Measure 11" in to set one corner of the angle supports and then aligned it to touch
